## **Empower Change, Inspire Action**

YMCA Leicestershire has been providing community services within the city and county for the last 140 years; it is the largest voluntary sector provider of supported housing for young people within the city and houses 117 young people each night. The organisation also delivers a range of other services (from its eight sites) specifically focused on young people these include; Education and training, sports, arts, residential care, outreach and resettlement, advice and information. Additionally, the organisation has a 300-seat professional Victorian theatre, bar and a range of sports facilities which include 17 acres of sports fields (leased to Leicester City Football Club as part of their youth academy).

YMCA Leicestershire is a Christian Charity, Registered Social Landlord, Housing Association and Company Limited by Guarantee. Our primary purpose is to support young people to develop skills, raise confidence and make positive transitions in society.
